SUBJECT: Taxiway F1 Rehabilitation Questions/Answers

The Yuma County Airport Authority, Inc. (YCAA) appreciates your interest in this project. Provided below are Questions received along with Responses provided by the YCAA.

Q1: Section B is allotted 50 points, is the breakdown 25 points each for B1 and B2?

A1: No. Point allotment for Section B is allocated as follows:

- Section B1 has a maximum of 40 points available.
- Section B2 has a maximum of 10 points available.

Q2: Are the taxiway shoulders to be included in the rehabilitation design?

A2: Yes, design should include reconstruction of the taxiway shoulders 25' off or as specified in the advisory circular as determined by the width of the taxiway.

Q3: Is rehabilitation of the rigid pavement at the intersection of Taxiway F1 and H1 to be included in the design?

A3: Yes, this will be determined by the selected firm. This area will be evaluated during the topography and analyze if the intersection needs rehabilitation.

Q4: Should the Taxiway specifications match that of the outboard runway?

A4: Yes

Q5: Should Taxiway lighting be incorporated into the design?

A5: Yes

Q6: Has a Cat Ex already been submitted?

A6: Yes.

Q7: Will the YCAA provide adjacent project files?

A7: Yes, the YCAA will provide project files adjacent to this project to the firm awarded the contract.

Q8: Does the YCAA encourage DBE participation?

A8: Yes

Q9: Can the submittal include a Table of Contents?

A9: Yes, the cover letter/table of contents will not be counted towards the 10-page max. Resumes are limited to 2 pages maximum.

Q10: Will the YCAA perform an IFE?

A10: Yes, the YCAA will hire an experienced firm to prepare an Independent Fee Estimate (IFE) concurrently while negotiating with the selected firm on their proposed fee schedule.

Q11: Will the YCAA prepare the project's construction Scope of Work?

A11: The Scope of Work for the design is contained in the RFQ. The contracted Firm will be responsible for preparing all construction documents necessary to bid the project to interested construction contractors, including the final construction Scope of Work.

Q12: Will the project include replacing the Taxiway F1 signs?

A12: Yes.
