

The Yuma County Chamber of Commerce hosted its annual Community Expo late September, its theme, Connecting Community.

Since aviation has been a key part of Yuma's history and connecting communities since 1911, Yuma International Airport proudly jumped at the chance to showcase Yuma's Aviation organizations in the venue lobby including Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, US Army Yuma Proving Grounds, Civil Air Patrol, Guardian Flight, Yuma Aeromodeler's Club, the Experimental Aircraft Association and Piedmont Airlines. The event gave each agency the opportunity to share information about their organization, their projects and upcoming events.



CELEBRATING YUMA'S AVIATION HISTORY

90th Anniversary of the 1st Women's National Air Derby



On August 18th, 1929, twenty women pilots entered the first official women-only air race in the United States from Santa Monica, CA to Cleveland, OH. The stop in Yuma, Arizona was requested by all of the participating aviatrixes. To commemorate the 90th anniversary of this historic event, Yuma International Airport hosted a Fly-In and unveiled a new mural celebrating the aviatrixes. Our guest of honor was Gene Nora Jessen who authored the book, Sky Girls. During the celebratory luncheon we played the documentary, Breaking Through The Clouds.



70th Anniversary of the Endurance Flight

When World War II ended, so did military aviation in Yuma. To spark interest and revive the economy, local Jaycees came up with an idea to spotlight Yuma's perfect weather: set a record for non-stop flying. An Aeronca Sedan named the "City of Yuma" took off on August 24, 1949, and didn't touch the ground again until October 10. The plane's record-setting 1,124 hours aloft were made possible by volunteers who passed food and fuel to pilots Woody Jongeward and Bob Woodhouse from a speeding convertible. The original plane was located and returned to Yuma in 1997. It flew to mark the flight's 50th anniversary, and through volunteer efforts and donations now hangs in the atrium of City Hall. The plane and related free exhibits - including a video and recordings of radio broadcasts from 1949 - can viewed during regular city hall hours, call or for schedule.



108th Anniversary of Robert Fowler landing in Yuma

On October 25, 1911, Robert Fowler landed his plane in Yuma on the site of where the Yuma Landing Bar & Grill is located. Mr. Fowler was the first person to land his aircraft not only in Yuma, but in the entire state of Arizona. A bronze statue of Mr. Fowler is located in the parking lot and the restaurant is a time capsule of historic aviation history is proudly displayed in the restaurant located at 195 South 4th Avenue.
