
Happy Retirement Lynn Hall!

MCC & Airport Ambassadors Return

The Yuma International Airport family is thrilled to have our beloved Military Comfort Center (MCC) and Airport Ambassador volunteers back!

The Military Comfort Center (MCC) was created to provide a relaxing atmosphere for members of the military, their family members and retired military who travel to and from the airport. The MCC is staffed entirely by volunteers who come to the airport faithfully every day between 6 am to 6:30 pm to watch over the center and care for the military members who go through it while waiting on their transportation.

Airport Ambassadors help airport patrons with questions they may have and way-finding. The volunteers, who have all had their COVID shots, have been chomping at the bit to get back into action doing what they love, helping the airport's guests with information and a bit of comfort prior to their travels.

The airport halted the MCC and Ambassador programs in March 2020 in an effort to protect its volunteers and the community during the pandemic. During its closure, the airport team updated the MCC with plush furniture for guests to sprawl out on and partnered with the Yuma County Library District as a hub for its new Pop-Up Library initiative. The MCC also features a variety of books, TVs, and computers for additional entertainment.


Yuma Orchestra Association
